64B5-2.013	Dental Examination Requirements and Grading	2/3/08	Revises some of the procedures and requirements for the Florida dental examination, effective 8/1/08
64B5-13.0046	Citation Authority	2/7/08	Adds as a citation offense failure to pay the one-time assessment fee by 2/28/2008
64B5-16.005	Remediable Tasks Delegable to Dental Assistants	3/24/08	Changes in language and supervision levels for several delegable duties
64B5-16.006	Remediable Tasks Delegable to Dental Hygienists	3/24/08	Changes in language and supervision levels for several delegable duties
64B5-15.030	One-Time Fee	4/23/08	Corrects the date of the one-time fee and eliminates the reference to the written notice of the fee
64B5-2.0144	Licensure Requirements for Dental Hygiene Applicants from Unaccredited Schools or Colleges	5/08/08	Deletes unnecessary language to bring the rule into compliance with the 2006 legislative change
64B5-16.001	Definitions of Remediable Tasks and Supervision Levels	2/05/09	Adds that any tasks delegable to dental assistants will be delegable to dental hygienists under the same supervision level, unless otherwise stated by rule
64B5-16.002	Required Training	4/27/09	Deletes "current Dental Assisting National Board, Inc. (DANB) credential" as acceptable form of formal Training
64B5-15.002	Application Fees	4/27/09	Establishes health access dental license application fee as \$100.00.
64B5-15.006	Licensure and Renewal Fees	4/27/09	Establishes health access dental license renewal fee as \$300.00.
64B5-17.006	Prescription Forms	5/28/09	Changes "work order" forms to prescription forms; deletes unnecessary language to clarify the period of retention of original prescriptions; adds new language to clarify requirements for a registered dental laboratory to perform work for another registered dental laboratory.
64B5-1.021	List of Approved Forms; Incorporation	5/28/09	Incorporates the health access dental license application into the rule.
64B5-2.013	Dental Examination Requirements and Grading	6/28/09	Clarifies language to include "Class III Composite" to the practical or clinical examination
64B5-2.0146	Licensure Requirements for Applicants From Non-Accredited Schools or Colleges	6/30/09	Deletes unnecessary language and adopts language adding new supplemental dental education requirements for dental licensure applicants that graduated from unaccredited dental schools or from schools not approved by the board.

64B5-16.006	Remediable Tasks Delegable To A Dental Hygienist	7/20/09	Amends supervision levels for several tasks and adds new language concerning monitoring and removal of in-office bleaching materials, after placement by the dentist as well as ability to insert and/or perform minor adjustments to sports mouth guards and custom fluoride trays.
64B5-16.007	Levels of Supervision For Dental Hygienists	7/20/09	Adds language that dental hygienists may apply fluoride varnishes without supervision.
64B5-2.0135	Dental Hygiene Examination	12/31/09	Changes requirements for dental hygiene exam clinical exam to include a simulated patient part of the clinical as well as a patient based part; defines grading criteria.
64B5-2.014	Licensure Requirements for Applicants from Accredited Schools or Colleges	4/26/10	Incorporates application forms for dental and dental hygiene examinations.
64B5-2.0144	Licensure Requirements for Dental Hygiene Applicants from Unaccredited Dental Schools or Colleges	4/26/10	Incorporates application form for dental hygiene examination.
64B5-10.011	Retired Status and Reactivation of Retired Status License	6/9/10	Adds language to require that dentists must demonstrate compliance with rule regarding financial responsibility; requires a dentist whose license has been on retired status for more than five years to appear before the Credentials Committee of the board.
64B5-4.004	Advertising Specialty Services	7/5/10	Repealed. Statute found unconstitutional in DuCoin vs. Dept. of Health.
64B5-14.005	Application for Permit	7/5/10	Clarifies that applicants for sedation permits must document actual clinical administration of anesthetics to 20 dental or oral and maxillofacial patients.
64B5-2.013	Dental Examination Requirements & Grading	8/25/10	Allows candidates to substitute passing scores obtained on the Florida certified diagnostic skills examination used to obtain NERB status to fulfill FL licensure requirement if examination was taken after September 1, 2008.
64B5-13.0046	Citation Authority	8/25/10	Adds penalty of \$150 for dentists not completing required CPR training; adds penalty of \$50 for dental hygienists not completing required CPR training; adds citation authority for submission of insufficient funds for initial license or renewal or any other payment to the Department of Health.
64B5-13.005	Disciplinary Guidelines	9/15/10	Amends disciplinary guidelines relating to convictions relating to state Medicaid or federal Medicare programs.
64B5-2.0135	Dental Hygiene Examinations	10/10/10	Allows candidates to substitute passing scores obtained on the Florida certified computer based assessment used to obtain NERB status to fulfill FL licensure requirement if examination was taken after January 6, 2010.
64B5-2.017	Acceptable Variance of Examiners	10/10/10	Deletes language relating to previous examination scoring method
64B5-12.013	Continuing Education Requirements	10/10/10	Allows anesthesia inspection consultants to receive two hours of continuing education credit each biennium.
64B5-16.006	Remedial Tasks Delegable To a Dental Hygienist	10/17/10	Allows dental hygienists to apply bleaching solution, activate light source, monitor and remove in-office bleaching materials under direct supervision.
