Ms. Rarback moved that changes to rules 64B8-42.002 and 64B8-42.001 would not be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory cost to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. TAB 9 Transfer of Funds into the Unlicensed Activity Account

The council had previously requested information regarding the transfer of funds between accounts. That information along with advertising quotes and statistical information about unlicensed activity complaints was provided and considered.

Discussion included types of advertising possibilities, previous education/unlicensed activity campaigns as well as the different areas to be addressed in developing a campaign.

Some points of information that may help with direction include an understanding of the complaint process from start to finish, including timeframes and the steps involved. Staff was directed to include information about the process at the next meeting. Ms. Hall indicated that he would request someone from the unlicensed activity unit attend the meeting to answer any questions the council may have.

Ms. Jones shared that internet and internet applications advertising may be a viable method of advertising given the trends in communication today. Ms. Jones further indicated that she will research and provide information on cost with a few associations that advertise online. Any information gathered will be forwarded to staff for inclusion on the August agenda.
