This case was brought before the Probable Cause Panel on December 28, 2010 on a two count Administrative Complaint alleging that the Subject violated sections 458.331(1)(l)(s), by soliciting patients, and by being unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of mental condition.

The Department re-evaluated the evidence and reconsidered the charges best suited to be prosecuted in this case and presented to the Panel, for its reconsideration, an Amended Administrative Complaint which alleged violations relating to sections 458.331(1)(s), F.S., by being unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of mental condition; and 456.072(1)(hh), F.S., by being terminated from a treatment program without good cause. The panel discussed to circumstances of the case and approval of the Amended Administrative Complaint.

After discussion, a motion was made and seconded to approve the Amended Administrative Complaint. The panel voted to approve the Amended Administrative Complaint.
