Tab 1 – Modification of Rule 64B8-52.003, F.A.C. – Procedure for Approval of Attendance at Continuing Education Courses.

Mr. Tellechea advised the committee of an issue with the language of the proposed rule change. He suggested that the Committee revise the proposed rule language to read:

“(2) All licensees shall be awarded contact hours for attendance at all offerings that are approved by the Electrolysis Society of Florida (ESF), or the Electrolysis Association of Florida (EAF), or the American Electrology Association, or the Society of Clinical and Medical Hair Removal, and all offerings from other states which are approved by the states’ licensing agency or professional electrology organization which offerings have been approved by the American Electrology Association, or the Society of Clinical and Medical Hair Removal, or any ~~technical school, college or university course, or course from a Board approved program pursuant to 64B8-53.001, F.A.C.,~~ taken and successfully completed for the first time by the licensee in a subject area relevant to electrolysis. The licensee shall provide verification upon request of the Department.

Dr. Tucker made a motion to approve the proposed rule language as suggested by counsel. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Action taken: the Committee voted to approve the proposed language as suggested by counsel.
