

Licensed Midwifery

Licensure Examination Requirements

For those candidates who are eligible and have not yet secured licensure in any other state.

General Requirements

- 21 years of age when applying for licensure
- Submit application to the Council office
- Proof of Liability Insurance in the amount of \$100,000 per claim and \$300,000 minimum annual aggregate.
- Must have completed one of the approved midwifery programs.
- Must provide proof of passing the North American Registry of Midwives written examination
- Payment of all applicable fees
- Passed the college level academic scholastic test (CLAST) or taken three college-level credits each of math and English, or can demonstrate competencies in communication and computation by passing the College Level Equivalent Proficiency (CLEP) test in communication and computation.

Examination Information

The North American Registry of Midwives' (NARM) written examination is Florida's midwifery licensure examination. Any person desiring to be licensed as a midwife shall apply to the NARM to take the licensure examination.
