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**DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

**DETERMINATION OF WAIVER**

**TAB 1        Scott Joseph Vajner, OTA 6840, DOH Case No: 2010-00914**  
Informal Waiver/Default, (PCP Members: Mullings and Johnson)

Mr. Vajner was not present nor represented by legal counsel.

Mr. Mullings was recused from this case due to participation in the Probable Cause Panel.

Mr. Vajner's current address on record with the Department is: 6113 Marjo Drive, Tampa, FL 33617.

Ms. Shah summarized the case for the Board. Mr. Vajner failed to provide proof of completion of two (2) hours of Prevention of Medical Errors, two (2) hours of Florida Laws and Rules for Occupational Therapy, and four (4) additional general hours of continuing education as required for the 3/1/2007 - 2/28/2009 renewal biennium. During each biennium, as established by the

Department, each licensee must earn 26 contact hours of continuing education, including two (2) hours of Prevention of Medical Errors, two (2) hours of Florida Laws and Rules for Occupational Therapy, and twenty two (22) additional general hours.

Mr. Vajner choose to accept a Non- Non-Disciplinary Citation as a Final Order of the Board, by signing and dating the citation August 31, 2009, which was filed on September 16, 2009. The citation required Mr. Vajner to submit \$200 penalty and \$75 costs, with proof of completion of the pending two (2) hours of Prevention of Medical Errors, two (2) hours of Florida Laws and Rules for Occupational Therapy, and four (4) additional general hours of continuing education. The citation required payment within 30 days of the filing of the order, by December 16, 2009. No such hours or payment have been submitted by Mr. Vajner.

An Administrative Complaint was filed on August 6, 2010 charging Mr. Vajner with violating Section 468.217(1)(x), Florida Statutes (2009) which provides that violating any provision of this chapter or chapter 456, or any rules adopted pursuant thereto, constitutes grounds for disciplinary action by the Board of Occupational Therapy; and Section 456.072(1)(q), Florida Statutes (2009) by violating a lawful order of the Department or Board which constitutes grounds for disciplinary action by the Board of Occupational Therapy.

The Administrative Complaint package was returned to the Department unclaimed. The Department concluded with a diligent search and attempted to hand deliver the package to several known addresses, unsuccessfully. The Department published a Notice of Action in a public newspaper in Hillsborough County, on four different dates over a span of 30 days. Mr. Vajner has not provided a response to the allegations.

**MOTION:** Ms. Banta made a motion to find that the Mr. Vajner was properly served and has waived his right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried 4/0.

**MOTION:** Ms. Banta made a motion to adopt the allegations of fact in the Administrative Complaint as the findings of fact of the Board. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried 4/0.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hall made a motion to find the allegations and conclusions of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint constitutes a violation of the Florida Statutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried 4/0.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson made a motion to accept the investigative report and exhibits into evidence for the purposes of imposing penalty. The motion was seconded by Ms. Banta and carried 4/0.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion to find Mr. Vajner in violation of the Florida Statutes as charged in the Administrative Complaint to impose the following penalties to Mr. Vajner's license:

- Reprimand,
- \$500 Fine,
- Suspension until compliant with fine and proof of completion of the pending continuing education, of 2 hours in Prevention of Medical Errors, 2 hours of Florida Laws and Rules and 4 general continuing education hours.

Authority was delegated to the Chair to lift the Suspension once Mr. Vajner is in compliance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried 4/0.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to access the costs of \$822.82 and to include payment of the costs as a component of the Suspension until compliant motion. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried 4/0.

Mr. Lewy briefed the Board on HB 1565 which amends the rulemaking procedures with respect to agencies' preparation of a statement of estimated regulatory cost (SERC) for proposed rules and requires legislative ratification of certain rules.

- Executive Order Suspending Rulemaking

Mr. Lewy briefed the Board on the Executive Order issued by Governor Scott which suspends all rulemaking. However, the Board will continue to discuss rules so that when the suspension is lifted, rulemaking can presume as quickly as possible.

Mr. Lewy provided a current rules report stating the previous revisions for Rule 64B11-2.003, F.A.C., Application/Fees (OT), and Rule 64B11-3.001, F.A.C., Application/Fees (OTA), incorporating the web address by which OT and OTA applicants may apply online for licensure were published for development 8/2/2010. The notice was published 10/6/10 and still in the rulemaking process due to additional requirements requested by the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC). JAPC requested the online application to be incorporated by reference in the rule text, to include the effective date of the application, and for a copy of the online application to be submitted for review. Additionally, JAPC requests the Board to determine if the rules will have an adverse impact on small business, or if the proposed rules are likely to directly, or indirectly increase regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 within one

year after implementation of the rule, and if so, a statement of estimated regulatory costs must also be prepared.

**Rule 64B11-2.003, F.A.C.**

Ms. Watson made a motion approve the rule language as presented. Ms. Banta seconded the motion which carried 5/0.

Ms. Watson made a motion stating the rule would not have an adverse impact on small business, nor increase regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 within one year after implementation of the rule. Ms. Banta seconded the motion which carried 5/0.

**Rule 64B11-3.001, F.A.C.**

Ms. Watson made a motion made a motion approve the rule language as presented. Ms. Banta seconded the motion which carried 5/0.

Ms. Watson made a motion stating the rule would not have an adverse impact on small business, nor increase regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 within one year after implementation of the rule. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion which carried 5/0.

The Board instructed Board Counsel to take any additional actions needed for promulgation of these rules.

The Board discussed and proposed questions for additional research regarding if there are other monitoring companies, other than the "Affiliated Monitors" program that was presented to the Board, and utilized by the Board of Medicine, and if there is regulation of such companies. The Board additionally discussed adding it would be the licensee's responsibility to pay for such monitor's services, in the new proposed language.
