DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS

INFORMAL HEARING

TAB 1 Margarita James Vagnier, OTA 9513, DOH Case 2010-01583

Ms. Vagnier's current address on record with the Department is: 3 Briggs Drive, Ormond Beach, FL 32176.

Mr. Mullings was recused for this case, due to his participation on the Probable Cause Panel. Ms. Vagnier was present for the meeting and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Shah summarized case # 2010-01583 for the Board.

An Administrative Complaint was filed on June 30, 2008, against Ms. Vagnier upon failing to provide proof of 26 hours of continuing education (CE) hours, determined by a CE audit for the

03/01/05 – 02/28/2007 licensure biennium. Ms. Vagnier was granted an extension of time, until October 5, 2007, to submit the required continuing education hours, due to her financial hardships. On October 17, 2007, the Department determined Ms. Vagnier had not submitted proof of completion of the required courses. A citation was issued on 02/01/08. On 02/27/08, Ms. Vagnier responded by disputing the citation and admitted she did not complete the required continuing education hours. As of 04/30/08, Ms. Vagnier had not provided proof of deficient CE hours. An Administrative Complaint was filed stating Ms. Vagnier failed to perform a statutory or legal obligation placed upon a licensed occupational therapy assistant when she failed to provide proof of completing two hours of Florida Laws and Rules, two hours of Prevention of Medical Errors, and twenty-two hours of General Continuing Education coursework, as required by Rule 64B11-5.001, F.A.C., for the biennium of 03/01/05 – 02/28/07, thus violating Section 468.217(1)(h), F.S. (2006).

A Final Order was filed on December 24, 2008 following an Informal Hearing by the Board of Occupational Therapy Practice imposing the following disciplinary actions:

- Letter of Concern
- \$100.00 fine to be paid within sixty (60) days due February 23, 2008
- \$905.76 cost to be paid within one year, due December 23, 2009.
- Compliance by providing proof of completing the required 26 hours within ninety (90) days, due March 25, 2008. The underlying continuing education credits are to be taken in addition to the continuing education requirements for the current biennium.

At the May 18, 2009, meeting of the Board, the Compliance Unit submitted a letter from Ms. Vagnier requesting an extension of time to pay the fees imposed, due to financial hardship. The Board determined to place the case in abeyance to allow time for Ms. Vagnier to submit correspondence detailing the specific assistance needed with continuing education and fines, and to submit additional documents to support her claim of financial difficulties.

At the August 17, 2009, meeting of the Board, the Compliance Unit again submitted a letter from Ms. Vagnier requesting an extension to pay the fees imposed, due to financial hardship. The Board made a motion to table this item until the November meeting to allow Ms. Vagnier another opportunity to detail the relief she is seeking with regard to payment of fines and costs. The Board requested Staff to send a letter to Ms. Vagnier expressing the importance of communicating with the Board by the next meeting.

At the November 2, 2009, meeting of the Board, the Compliance Unit again submitted this case for review based on correspondence received from Ms. Vagnier regarding financial difficulties. Although Ms. Vagnier provided a response to staff's letter, the Board determined there was insufficient evidence to indicate feasible alternatives that the Board might consider, and rejected any further extension of time to pay fees imposed.

On August 3, 2010, an Administrative Complaint was filed stating Ms. Vagnier had not provided payment of fines in the amount of \$100 or costs of \$905.76, as required by the Final Order, and therefore, she violated Section 468.217(1)(v), F.S. (2009) and Section 468.217(1)(x), F.S. (2009) and Section 456.072(1)(q), F.S. (2009).

Ms. Shah presents this case to the Board as a Motion for Determination of Waiver and Entry of Final Order Following Hearing, stating Ms. Vagnier has not responded to dispute the Administrative Complaint and has waived her right to elect a method of resolution of this matter. In addition, a Motion to Assess Costs for \$497.59 is included, stating this assessment of costs is

in addition to any other (previous) discipline imposed by the Board. Ms. Shah requests the Board impose discipline in accordance with the disciplinary guidelines and enter a Final Order.

MOTION: Ms. Watson made a motion to make a finding that the Respondent was properly served. Ms. Garcia seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

MOTION: Ms. Dunbar made a motion to adopt the findings of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint as the conclusions of fact in this proceeding. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

MOTION: Ms. Banta made a motion to adopt the allegations of law as the conclusions of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint and find that this constitutes a violation of the Board of Occupational Therapy Practice Act. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

MOTION: Ms. Banta made a motion to accept the materials under Tab 1 into evidence for the purpose of imposing penalties. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

MOTION: After Discussion, Ms. Dunbar made a motion to impose a Reprimand and Suspension of license until compliant with the previous final order, which includes previous fines. The Board waived the fine due to mitigating factors of extreme financial hardship regarding care of a disabled sister and care of aging and ill parents stating Ms. Vagnier has completed the deficient continuing education hours for the 2005-2007 biennium.

Ms. Dunbar seconded the motion which carried with 3/0 votes, 1 opposing vote. Ms. Banta made a motion to accept the penalty of costs, totaling \$497.59 with three (3) years to pay, as recommended by the Prosecuting Attorney. Ms. Dunbar seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to accept the Prosecutor's Report including approval for Ms. Shah to continue to prosecute cases more that one year old. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

TAB 4 Charles A. Dwigins, OT 359, Clear/Active

Mr. Dwigins was not required to attend this meeting but was sent a notice and invitation to appear. Mr. Dwigins was present for the meeting and sworn in by the court reporter.

Mr. Charles Dwigins submitted an application for Exemption from Disqualification to seek employment in a health care facility licensed under Chapter 400, Florida Statutes, due to results of a Level II background screening. She is requesting exemption from disqualification from employment in positions covered by s. 400.512 (Nursing Homes and Related Health Care Facilities) and chapter 435 (Employment Screening) of the Florida Statutes. An exemption provides eligibility for employment despite the presence of a disqualifying offense(s).

The disqualifying offense indicated in Mr. Dwigins background screening report was committed in 1988, before his original date of licensure on 03/01/77. Mr. Dwigins submitted proof of completion of all court requirements with his exemption application. No records were found where Mr. Dwigins reported such charges to the DEPT or Board. Mr. Dwigins has a Clear/Active Florida license with no discipline history.

MOTION: Following a discussion, Ms. Dunbar made a motion to **grant** Mr. Dwigins' Exemption request. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

TAB 5 Taisha Trotman, OTA 10609, Clear/Active

Ms. Trotman was not required to attend this meeting but was sent a notice and invitation to appear. Ms. Trotman was present for the meeting and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Taisha Trotman submitted an application for Exemption from Disqualification to seek employment in a health care facility licensed under Chapter 400, Florida Statutes, due to results of a Level II background screening. She is requesting exemption from disqualification from employment in positions covered by s. 400.512 (Nursing Homes and Related Health Care Facilities) and chapter 435 (Employment Screening) of the Florida Statutes. An exemption provides eligibility for employment despite the presence of a disqualifying offense(s).

The disqualifying offense indicated in Ms. Trotman's background screening report was committed in 2002, while in the US Air Force, before her original date of licensure on 12/12/07. Ms. Trotman submitted documentation received from the USAF to document the court proceedings and requirements with her exemption application. No records were found where Ms. Trotman reported such charges to the DEPT or Board. Ms. Trotman has a Clear/Active Florida license with no discipline history.

MOTION: Following a discussion, Mr. Mullings made a motion to **grant** Ms. Trotman's Exemption request. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

APPLICANT RATIFICATION LISTS

TAB 6 Endorsement Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants

MOTION: Mr. Mullings moved to approve the ratification list of applicants for licensure, 121 names, including 14 names on an addendum list, totaling 128 names. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

ACTION TAKEN: 135 names ratified for licensure by endorsement.

TAB 7 Examination Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants

MOTION: Ms. Dunbar moved to approve for licensure, pending the successful passage of the NBCOT examination, ratification list of applicants for licensure as noted, 119 names, including 23 names on an addendum list, totaling 142 names. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

ACTION TAKEN: 142 names approved for licensure pending successful exam results.

TAB 8 Exam With Waiver: Occupational Therapists & Assistants

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to approve the list of 3 applicants for licensure, by Examination with Waiver. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

ACTION TAKEN: 3 names approved for licensure by exam with waiver.

TAB 9 Continuing Education Provider Applications

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to approve the 8 continuing education providers as listed for ratification. There were no providers offering Prevention of Medical Errors courses, and Laws and Rules courses at this time. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

ACTION TAKEN: 8 continuing education provider applications were approved.

RULES REVIEW AND/OR DEVELOPMENT

TAB 10 RULES REVIEW AND/OR DEVELOPMENT - Rule 64B11-4.003, F.A.C.

Per the Board's request, at the January 10, 2011 Meeting, the Board tabled the Rule Development on this rule until the April 11, 2011 meeting to allow additional research. Staff inquired of the Board of Medicine staff and its compliance representative and was informed that Affiliated Monitors is the only company that is known to provide monitoring services to its licensees. In performing general research, staff was also unable to locate any other companies who provide services specifically to health care practitioner licensees.

Staff contacted Affiliated Monitors to inquire of its known competitors, as well, and was informed that there are not any others who provide the same type of monitoring for practitioners as it does. Mr. Vincent DiCianni, president of Affiliated, who presented information to the Board at a

previous Board meeting, asked that it be communicated to you, again, that the costs incurred by a licensee for monitoring are a factor of both the breadth (supervisory review criteria) and duration (probation timeframe) of the requirements of the monitoring. Mr. DiCianni indicated that there is no particular oversight for his company; however, quality assurance is maintained by ensuring that its monitors are quality, local, licensed practitioners.

The Board staff made inquiry to the Florida Occupational Therapy Association (FOTA), the practice section of the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA), and the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) regarding this matter. There were no responses provided.

At the April 11, 2011 Board Meeting the Board tabled this item and requested counsel to prepare proposed language for the July 11, 2011 meeting agenda.

At the July 11, 2011 meeting Mr. Lewy submitted proposed language for the Board's review. The Board discussed and included additional revisions, and requested Counsel to revise the language and bring back for the Board's review and approval at the October 10, 2011 meeting.

MOTION: Ms. Banta made a motion to approve the draft language as presented by Mr. Levy with one amendment stating, "The Board Chair or any other members as delegated by the Board". Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

MOTION: Ms. Watson made a motion that this rule would have no adverse impact on small businesses. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.

MOTION: Ms. Banta made a motion to approve the language as written in the Addendum Tab. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion, which carried 5/0.
