Call to Order: Jennifer Lalani, Chair

TAB 1: Approve Minutes from March 26, 2008, Meeting

MOTION: by Powers, second by Lalani to approve minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 2: 64B16-28.140 - Record Keeping

Ms. Poston, Ms. Loucks and Mr. Powers worked on the revisions but did not complete it. The document will be ready for the August Board meeting. Mr. Powers commended Ms. Poston and Ms. Loucks for their work.

TAB 3: 64B16-27.420 - Pharmacy Technician 2:1 or 3:1 Ratio

Senate Bill 1360 has not been signed by the Governor yet. Table this item under Old Business until ready to prepare rules for SB 1360.

Kathy Mezerick, Executive Director of the Florida Association of Postsecondary Schools and Colleges, introduced herself and said she would work with the Board staff in providing information and data as part of the implementation of the bill.

TAB 4: 64B16-27.430 - Responsibilities of the Pharmacist

Ms. Loucks and Mr. Parrado will work together on this and be prepared to discuss at the next meeting.

TAB 5: 64B16-27.700 – Office Use Compounding

The bill in the legislature did not pass that gives us the statutory authority to do this. Ms. Loucks suggested moving forward with rule. No changes since the February meeting, notice language as is.

TAB 6: 64B16-28.301 - Destruction of Controlled Substances

Anthony Sacini, Consultant Pharmacy, Inc., is pursuing legislative changes through the FPA.

TAB 7: Email from Hal Wiggins, Pharm.D., Hernando Pasco Hospice

Dr. Wiggins is the Director of Pharmacy Services at Hernando Pasco Hospice. He is concerned with increasing break-ins in their area. He was asking for an exemption to only put the name and phone number on the labels and leave the address off in order to provide some security and protection.

MOTION: by Powers, second by Parrado to deny request for exemption. Motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Poston will respond to Mr. Wiggins. Must maintain a standard that is in current rule.

TAB 8: DEP Disposition of Prescription Medications

Ms. Laurie Tenace and Raul Clarke from the Department of Environmental Protection made a presentation regarding disposal of non-controlled medications (handouts attached). They will provide informational material to the department for distribution.

TAB 9: CE for Pain Management (Board of Medicine Rule)

This issue resulted from the Drug Summit held in February in conjunction with the Boards of Medicine, Osteopathic Medicine, Nursing, and Pharmacy. There was a discussion as to whether there was a need for specific pain management CE hours for pharmacists. The consensus of the committee was that there was a need for pain management CEs but it should not be required, important but not mandatory.

Motion: by Powers, second by Goersch to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
