TAB 1 Approval of Minutes from June 9, 2009, Meeting

MOTION: by Powers, second by Griffin to approve minutes as amended. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 2 Rule Status Report- Diane Guillemette, Assistant Attorney General

Ms. Guillemette reported that the August rules report would be in a more detailed format. Rule 64B16-27.420 and 25.170 had not been noticed for rule development yet.

TAB 3 64B16-26.402 Pharmacy Permit Application; Community, Special Pharmacies

The following changes were suggested:

Line 10 – After permittee, insert “the applicant shall obtain a passing departmental inspection on the facility”.

Line 14 – after applicant, delete “and” and insert “as well as the prescription department manager for..”

Line 37 – at the end of the sentence, delete “and” and insert “to ensure compliance with this section.”

MOTION: by Salem, second by Powers to place on August Rules Committee Agenda with suggested changes. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 4 64B16-28.502 Class I Institutional Permit and Class II Institutional Permit Labels and Labeling of Medicinal Drugs

The following changes were suggested:

Line 17 – capitalize “The”

MOTION: by Powers, second by Weizer to approve changes and forward to full board with recommendation to adopt changes and move to rule promulgation. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 5 64B16-28.702 Modified Class II Institutional Pharmacy Permit

The following changes were suggested:

Line 11 – After permittee, insert “the applicant shall obtain a passing departmental inspection on the facility”

Line 20 – Medicinal drugs purchased by the facility may only be administered on the premises, except to patients of the institution.

Line 47 – After consultant pharmacist, insert “of record”

MOTION: by Powers, second by Griffin to approve changes and forward to full board with recommendation to adopt changes and move to rule promulgation. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 6 64B16-28.800 Special Pharmacies

The following changes were suggested:

Line 10 – Spell out ALF – Assisted Living Facility

MOTION: by Powers, second by Weizer to move this language into 26.402 and place on August Rules Committee Agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 7 64B16-28.820 Special Pharmacy-Sterile Products and Special Parenteral/Enteral Compounding Permit

The following changes were suggested:

Lines 12-20 – Delete – duplicative

Line 48-49 – delete “of record”.

Line 135 – Safe Handling of Hazardous Drugs (published by the American Society of Health System Pharmacists)

MOTION: by Powers, second by Weizer to approve changes and forward to full board for appropriate action. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 8 64B16-28.870 Special ALF
• PDM/Consultant Grid

The following changes were suggested:

Line 1 – Spell out ALF – Adult Living Facility

Line 12-13 – Do not delete sentence. After notified, insert “by the permittee”

MOTION: by Salem, second by Weizer to approve changes and forward to full board with recommendation to adopt changes and move to rule promulgation. Motion carried unanimously.

TAB 9 64B16-28.902 Nuclear Pharmacy- Minimum Requirements
