Any person who receives a community pharmacy permit pursuant to Section 465.018, F.S., ~~and commences to operate such an establishment~~ shall keep the prescription department of the establishment open for a minimum of 40 hours per week and a minimum of five (5) days per week.

The committee reviewed correspondence to Governor Crist recommending written description and/or printed information containing pictorial representation of the medication be contained on the prescription label or patient information. The committee requested Ms. Loucks and Ms. Poston to reach out to other states and see what they are doing regarding this and prepare draft language to include written or pictorial descriptions of medication.
