12 **REVIEW OF MINUTES**

13 **Tab 1. March 4, 2011 Credentials Committee Meeting minutes**

14 Dr. Stephen Bloomfield moved to accept the minutes. Dr. Dean Aufderheide seconded the  
15 motion, which carried 4/0.

16 **APPLICANTS FROM APA ACCREDITED PROGRAMS FOR EXAMINATION AND**  
17 **LICENSURE AS NOTED**

18 **Tab 2. List of Applicants**

19 Dr. Luis Orta moved to ratify the list of applicants. Dr. Stephen Bloomfield seconded the motion,  
20 which carried 4/0.

21 **REVIEW OF APPLICATION FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION PROVIDER STATUS &**  
22 **MEDICAL ERRORS COURSE APPROVAL**

23 **Tab 3. U.S. Journal Training**

24 "32<sup>nd</sup> annual Training Institution on Behavioral Health and Addictive Disorders"  
25 Course No.: 20-293543

26 A representative from U.S. Journal Training was not present, and was not represented by  
27 Counsel.

28 During the January 2011 meeting, the Continuing Education Committee approved U.S. Journal  
29 Training as an approved continuing education provider. However, in regard to the approval of  
30 the medical errors course, the committee tabled the course approval to allow the provider time  
31 to submit supplemental material with relevant issues directly related to psychologists, and

1 medical errors which effect psychologists across the spectrum of practice. Subsequently, U.S.  
2 Journal Training submitted a request to waive the 90 day requirement for Board action, and  
3 requested clarification in regard to the requested revision, which should include specific content  
4 related to psychology.

5 Dr. Stephen Bloomfield moved to allow the provider until the end of January 2012 to submit the  
6 requested medical errors materials. Dr. Luis Orta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

#### 7 **APPLICANT REQUESTS FOR EXTENSION PURSUANT TO §490.005(3)(b), F.S.**

##### 8 **Tab 4. Beverly Jean-Jacques**

9 Dr. Beverly Jean-Jacques was not present and was not represented by counsel.

10 Following discussion, Dr. Stephen Bloomfield moved grant the extension for an additional 12  
11 months. Dr. Luis Orta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

##### 12 **Tab 5. Tom Kennedy**

13 Dr. Kennedy was present and was not represented by counsel.

14 Following discussion, Dr. Luis Orta moved to grant the extension for an additional 12 months.  
15 Dr. Stephen Bloomfield seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

#### 16 **APPLICANT INQUIRY IN REGARD TO APPLICATION STATUS**

##### 17 **Tab 6. Cynthia Mascia (Endorsement of 20 Years Experience)**

18 Dr. Mascia was present and represented by her attorney, Stuart Christmas, Esq.

19 During the October 2010 meeting, Dr. Mascia was granted an additional six months to acquire a  
20 letter of APA comparability. Subsequently, Dr. Mascia informed staff of her difficulties in finding  
21 someone to prepare the required letter. During the meeting, Dr. Mascia and her attorney  
22 informed the Board of her decision to change her application method to Endorsement of Other  
23 State License.

24 Following the discussion Dr. Stephen Bloomfield to grant an extension until the July 22, 2011  
25 meeting, or sooner, to allow Dr. Mascia time to provide staff with the materials needed to  
26 process her application under the Endorsement of Other State License application method. Dr.  
27 Dean Aufderheide seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

#### 28 **REVIEW OF LICENSURE APPLICATION**

##### 29 **Tab 7. Beverly Vardi (Endorsement of Other State License)**

30 Dr. Vardi was not present and was not represented by counsel.

31 During the October 2010 meeting the Board voted to deny Dr. Vardi's application for failure to  
32 meet the educational requirements. A notice of intent to deny was filed in December 2010, and  
33 the application was denied by operation of law.

1 In February 2011, Dr. Vardi contacted the Board office to inquire about the status of her  
2 application, and indicated that she was unaware of the denial because the notice was sent to an  
3 address which she no longer resides.

4 Following discussion, Dr. Stephen Bloomfield moved to deny Dr. Vardi's request for  
5 reconsideration. Dr. Luis Orta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

### 7 **POST - DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

#### 8 **Tab 8. Johann Prewett**

9 Dr. Prewett was present and was not represented by counsel.

10 During the November 2010 Board Quorum, the Board accepted Dr. Prewett's payment related  
11 to multiple cases, and a return to work plan approved by PRN. Dr. Prewett was given  
12 authorization to complete a portion of the continuing education requirement through an online  
13 home study course, rather than a live presentation.

14 Subsequently, Dr. Prewett submitted proof of the completion of the continuing education  
15 requirement, and petitioned the Board for reinstatement of his psychology license. The Board  
16 also considered a letter from PRN in regard to Dr. Prewett's compliance with his monitoring  
17 contract.

18 Following discussion, Dr. Stephen Bloomfield moved to reinstate Dr. Prewett's license to  
19 practice psychology. Dr. Luis Orta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

#### 20 **Tab 9. Stanford Mintz**

21 Dr. Mintz was present and was not represented by counsel.

22 Dr. Mintz seeks approval to take his remaining required CE courses via home study to satisfy  
23 the final obligation pursuant to the Final Order in DOH case number 2008-15136.

24 Following discussion, Dr. Dean Aufderheide moved to allow Dr. Mintz to fulfill the record  
25 keeping continuing education requirement through an APA approved, or Board approved home  
26 study course. Dr. Luis Orta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

27 Following the proceedings, the Board was addressed by Debbie Troupe of Professionals  
28 Resource Network, Inc. (PRN) in regard to a continuing education course which will be offered  
29 by PRN in the fall.

30 The meeting adjourned at approximately 9:15 a.m.
