REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSURE

(The applicants were not present or represented at the committee meeting unless otherwise noted.)

Tab 1 Stacey Brodie-Walker (Examination)

Dr. Brodie-Walker was present.

Dr. Brodie-Walker received supervision in Jamaica from a psychologist licensed in Virginia. Jamaica does not offer licensure in psychology.

Following discussion, Dr. Rafael Rivas-Vazquez moved that supervision was the only issue of concern for the committee. The petition for variance or waiver is to be considered by the full board at the October 24, 2008 General Business meeting. Dr. Amy Swan seconded the motion, which carried 3/0.

Tab 2 Thomas Ryan (Examination)
